- Governor's initiative that became law in 2014
- Each district has an allocation: Alfred-Almond CSD: \$609,287
- No expiration on funds
- Requires a detailed Investment Plan

Smart School Investment Plan Process

BASIC STEPS

1. ITP – Instructional Technology Plan
2. Scope development
3. Collaboration with stakeholders 11/6/18
4. Finalize Scope
5. Letter of Intent to SED (project number established)
6. BOE preliminary (SSIP) approval 11/6/18
7. Web posting (30 Days) 11/7/18
8. Public hearing 1/9/19
9. Final plan approved by BOE 1/9/19
10. Final submission to SED 1/10/19
11. SSBA Review 1/10/19 to 7/10/19



Allowable Categories

- School Connectivity
- Classroom Technology
- Community Connectivity
- Pre-K Classroom Space
- Mobile Classroom Replacement
- *High-Tech Security Upgrades*



Preliminary Plan Scope

Scope Includes:

1. Classroom Access Control - \$360,000

Electrified locking door hardware with an automatic closer to ensure classrooms are secured during a lockdown.

2. Lockdown System - \$35,000

System used to initiate and communicate school building lockdown protocol.

3. Corridor Fire Door Release and Lock - \$105,000

Doors to be released and locked using the lockdown system. Egress is maintained and access through the building will be done with access control cards.


4. Project Incidentals - \$108,000

Known project costs such as Design, Construction Management, legal fees, bidding costs, etc..

5. Additional Exterior Doors with Access Control – Safe Act Funded

NY Safe Act Funds can be used to harden and access control to the remaining exterior building doors.
