**Alfred-Almond Central School Guidelines for a household positive.** If you are living in the same household as a positive case of COVID-19, testing is **STRONGLY** encouraged. Students and/or employees in the household who are not positive are permitted to attend school/work as long as they remain asymptomatic. Masking for 10 days is required in school and on district transportation during the 10-day period.
